Here I would like to discuss one of the main issues which was highlighted by Mohtram Mazhar Nawaz and Mohtram Zahoor Ahmad Dhareeja and that is less participation of Seraiki people especially young generation in Seraiki Movement.

I am not opposed to Seraiki province but any struggle for separate province without the support of people is just useless. People are source of power as said by Quaid-e-Awam.

So far, individual attempts have been made to raise this issue but no one really tried for combine effort. Before raising the issue of separate province we need to create awareness among Seraiki public about our heritage and culture.
