I noticed koonj has some problem in wasaib notepad. sf_Visakh is best technically. till now i noticed only one minor problem in it, that is, it give more space after digit 4 in Arabic. I will solve these issues in latter release (version 0.2). I gave more time to Visakh because in my view its best for publishing on paper. In latter release number of fonts will be increased. and dear all; Please inform me if you get any problem. things will be better with your support.
